5TH AND 6TH GRADE STUDENTS

Students who do not meet each deadline date will be dropped from the audition process.

Timeline

April 8, 2016 All **Recommendation Forms** must be completed and turned in to Ms. Thornberry.

***Please be sure to use the grading scale of 1-4**

April 15, 2016 **3 of your BEST works of art** turned in to Ms. Thornberry
These can be from art class or home. Remember to add variety when choosing subject matter (don't submit all cartoons, etc.). Works should be on paper with NO LINES, but can also be 3-dimensional.

April 25-29, 2016 **Interview/questionnaire**
2 in-house screening tasks

Ms. Thornberry will inform students who have submitted the completed recommendation form and 3 works of art **which days and times to meet in the Art classroom to complete in-house tasks.*

May 2, 2016 **3-d take home project due** to Ms. Thornberry (materials and instructions will be distributed during in-house screening tasks)

The completed portfolios will be evaluated by a team that consists of an art teacher, administrator, and a member of the art community (which may be an art teacher from another district school). The average total score for the portfolio must be 92% or higher to qualify for the GT Visual Arts Program.
